This policy forms part of the Brendan McKenna Earthmoving Integrated Management System (IMS) and provides the framework for setting vehicle safety and operational objectives.

The organisation recognises that vehicle use presents significant safety risks and is committed to identifying, assessing and controlling these risks.

The organisation is committed to:

- ensuring all company vehicles are operated safely and responsibly
- complying with all applicable road laws and regulatory requirements
- managing risks associated with vehicle use, including fatigue and distraction
- maintaining vehicles to ensure they are safe and roadworthy
- providing training, supervision and guidance to drivers
- protecting company assets through appropriate use and care of vehicles
- continually improving vehicle safety and management practices

Management will:

- ensure systems are in place for safe vehicle use and management
- provide resources for vehicle maintenance and compliance
- monitor driver behaviour and compliance with requirements
- take appropriate action where unsafe behaviour or breaches occur

All workers and contractors are required to:

- operate company vehicles safely and in accordance with legal requirements
- present fit for work when operating vehicles
- report incidents, damage or unsafe conditions
- comply with company procedures and directions relating to vehicle use

Company vehicle use is managed through procedures, risk assessments, maintenance systems and supervision in accordance with the Integrated Management System (IMS).
